

Tehran International Book Fair: Aladdin Project releases list of 200 anti-Semitic books

The Aladdin Project has compiled a list of more than 200 anti-Semitic books on display at Tehran International Book Fair, which took place between 4 and 14 May 2011. With over 5.5 million visitors, the

fair is the largest in the Middle East. Among the anti-Semitic books on display this year were new editions of Mein Kampf and the Protocols of the Elders of Zion. Fair organizers held a conference for the launch of a new book in Persian: The Holocaust and Revisionism, a compilation of writings of 37 Holocaust deniers from Europe, the United States, Australia and Japan, according to the Iranian news agency IBNA.


At the conference, participants called the Holocaust a "myth" and "lie propagated by the Zionists with enormous political and financial means," IBNA reported.

Soroush Nejad, one of the editors, told reporters that the book, published by the Tehran-based Institute for Policy Research, was set to be translated into several other languages of the Muslim world.

“The Zionists have spread the false story of the Holocaust through well-planned and well-funded propaganda," said Soroush Nejad in the conference. "Historical research has shown that there were not six million Jews in Europe before 1939, and even if there were, Hitler could not have arrested and killed all of them.”

Another panellist, Nasser Hassanpour, cited what he called "specific examples of how the Zionists have fabricated the Holocaust," and added: "The Zionists are conducting a worldwide campaign with more than 250 institutions and museums to support the lie of the Holocaust, and our duty is to provide facts and reasons to prove that the Holocaust never existed.”

The new book is one of more than 200 books with anti-Semitic content on display at this year’s Tehran International Book Fair. The Islamic Republic’s state-run foundations and organizations such as the Islamic Propaganda Organization and the Islamic Culture and Communications Organization regularly publish and distribute across the world books and brochures in Farsi, Arabic, Urdu and other languages with virulently anti-Semitic content.
